10. MAKE A SCRAPBOOK

How many pictures do we all have just sitting on our phones? Have your children go through your phone and
Pick out some of their favourites. Assemble them in a scrap book format.

11. Make an Ice Sun Catcher

• FIND COOL CAKE PANS OR OTHER SHAPES, FILL WITH WATER, AND LET FREEZE. THE RESULTING ICE SCULPTURE CAN BE PUT SOMEWHERE TO CAPTURE THE LIGHT AS THE SUN HITS IT. BONUS POINTS IF YOU PUT COOL DECORATIVE ITEMS IN YOUR SCULPTURE!

12. CREATE A MAGIC SHOW

• WE ALL HAVE SIMPLE UTENSILS IN OUR HOME THAT COULD BE USED TO CREATE A PRETTY COOL MAGIC SHOW. GREATE A WAND OUT OF CONSTRUCTION PAPER, LEARN A CARD TRICK ON YOUTUBE, ETC.

13. WRITE A STORY

 OUR DAUGHTER LOVES TO STAPLE PAPERS TOGETHER AND MAKE A BOOK. PERHAPS SET A THEME FOR INSPIRATION, OR LET THEIR LITTLE MINDS RUN WILD!

14. MAKE A PIZZA FROM SCRATCH

• MAKING PIZZA DOUGH CAN BE INCREDIBLY FUN FOR CHILDREN. LET THEM HELP YOU MEASURE AND ADD INGREDIENTS, THEN GIVE THEM THE FREEDOM TO PICK THEIR OWN TOPPINGS. PLUS, NOW DINNER IS DONE!

15. Have a Friendly Snowball Fight

BUILD A SHELTER, STOCK UP ON SOME SNOWBALLS AND PREPARE FOR WAR! JUST BE CAREFUL OF WHERE YOU AIM.

16. MAKE CARDS FOR OTHERS

• WE ARE SEPARATED FROM MANY OF OUR LOVED ONES AT THIS TIME, BUT THAT DOESN'T MEAN WE CAN'T MAKE THEM NICE CARDS! WRITE A CARD TO GRANDMA, OR PERHAPS TO A NEIGHBOUR. SHOW YOUR KIDS HOW A SIMPLE AND THOUGHTFUL CARD CAN BRIGHTEN SOMEONE ELSE'S DAY!

17. TRY TO MAKE A BOAT THAT FLOATS!

• TEACH YOUR CHILDREN ABOUT BUOYANCY AND THE PROPERTIES OF WATER ON VARIOUS ITEMS. MAKE A PAPER BOAT AND SHOW HOW QUICKLY IT CAN SINK ONCE IT BECOMES SATURATED. MAKE A SIMILAR BOAT AND HAVE THEM COLOUR IT WITH CRAYON TO GET A GOOD WAXY COATING. HAVE THEM COMPARE BUOYANCY. SIMILAR TO THIS, IF YOU HAVE CLAY YOU CAN CREATE SEPARATE MODELS AND PREDICT WHAT WILL AND WON'T FLOAT. EXPAND THOSE LITTLE MINDS!

18. HAVE A MOVIE DAY

• BURNT OUT FROM DOING ACTIVITIES? IT'S OKAY TO HAVE A MOVIE DAY. JUST MAKE IT FUN. HAVE POPCORN LIKE AT THE MOVIES, DIM THE LIGHTS, ETC.

19. PLAY CARDS

SIMILAR TO THE BOARD GAME THEORY, TEACH YOUR KIDS SOME NEW CARD GAMES. THERE ARE PLENTY OF OPTIONS FOR
YOUNGER ONES, SUCH AS MEMORY, SNAP, OR GO-FISH, TO NAME A FEW!

20. BUILD A SNOWMAN

• EASY TO DO IF THE WEATHER CONDITIONS ARE RIGHT. IF THEY AREN'T, IT COULD BE TRICKIER, BUT DO YOUR BEST TO BUILD SOME SEMBLANCE OF A SNOWMAN OR ANIMAL OUT OF THE SNOW!

21. DO SOME PAINTING

 GET CREATIVE. WHIP OUT THE OLD PAINT AND LET THEM PAINT YOU A PRETTY PICTURE THAT CAN BE HUNG PROUDLY ON THE FRIDGE!

22. DESIGN A TREASURE HUNT/MAP

• THIS ONE DOES REQUIRE A BIT OF FORESIGHT. DRAW THE KIDS A TREASURE HUNT MAP WITH SOME COOL PRIZE AWAITING THEM AT THE END. THE TRICKIER, THE MORE TIME IT WILL TAKE!

23. PLAY HIDE AND SEEK

FIND SOME NEW HIDING SPOTS AROUND YOUR HOME AND GET THOSE KIDDOS TO FIND YOU (AND VICE VERSA).

24. MAKE SOCK PUPPETS

• WHEN YOU ARE CLEANING OUT YOUR BEDROOM (POINT 1) REMEMBER TO SAVE SOME OLD SOCKS. YOU CAN USE THEM TO MAKE PUPPETS WITH OLD BUTTONS, FABRIC, ETC. GET CREATIVE WITH IT!

25. POTATO PAINTING

• YOU CAN CUT SHAPES OUT OF A POTATO OR APPLE, DIP IN PAINT, AND STAMP ON PAPER. LET YOUR CHILDREN PICK THE COOL SHAPES THEY WILL USE!

26. BUILD A SNOW CATAPULT

• FIND SOME TWIGS AND OTHER OUTDOOR ITEMS TO BUILD A SNOW CATAPULT. SEE WHO CAN CATAPULT A SNOWBALL THE FURTHEST!

27. PRETEND YOU ARE KING OR QUEEN

• OR IN OUR HOUSE, PRINCESS ELSA OR ANNA. LET THEM DRESS UP AS THEIR FAVOURITE CHARACTER, BUILD A THRONE, AND LET THEM RULE THE LAND.

28. BAKE SOME COOKIES!

I REMEMBER PLANTING BEANS IN GRADE 3 AND HAVING ONE SET THAT WAS KEPT IN A DARK CLOSET AND ONE THAT WAS EXPOSED TO LIGHT. IT WAS A COOL EXPERIMENT TO SEE THE IMPACT OF SUN ON PLANTS. PUT OUT A PLASTIC SHEET OR SOME GARBAGE BAGS TO DO THIS PROJECT ON, AND LET THEM DIG AND GET DIRTY! BONUS POINTS IF YOU HAVE A POT THAT THEY CAN PAINT!

32. DECORATE A TREE (OUTSIDE)

Make strands of cereal or popcorn and hang them outside. The critters and birds in your yard will love it!

33. MAKE A FORT

Now is the time to whip out those old blankets, tie them to some chairs, and make a super awesome fort!
 Bonus points for separate rooms!

34. HAVE A TEA PARTY

• INVITE ALL OF YOUR STUFFED ANIMAL FRIENDS, SET THE TABLE, PUT ON YOUR SUNDAY BEST, AND HAVE A FORMAL TEA PARTY. PERHAPS EAT SOME OF THOSE COOKIES YOU BAKED PREVIOUS!

35. CREATE A PAPER TOWN

Use construction paper to create buildings, cars, roads, signs, trees, you name it. Get creative!

36. MAKE SOME MUSIC

 You can make some of your own instruments and create a band! Some rice in an old container for a rattle, a tissue-box guitar, a packing tape drum, and you've got your ensemble!

37. TIDY OUT THE PLAYROOM

• NOW IS A GREAT TIME TO DO AN EARLY "SPRING CLEAN" OF THE PLAYROOM. LET YOUR CHILDREN HELP YOU DECIDE WHAT TO KEEP, DONATE, OR THROW AWAY. IT IS A GREAT TIME TO SANITIZE AS YOU GO TOO!

OUEEN TEAM

38. GOOGLE "HOW TO DRAW..."

 Have your child pick something they would like to learn how to draw, and watch some YouTube videos or get step-by-step instructions on Google to educate yourself!

39. MAKE SNOW ANGELS

 WE RECENTLY HAD NEW SNOW FALL WHICH MEANS THERE ARE PLENTY OF GREAT SPOTS IN THE YARD TO CREATE BEAUTIFUL SNOW ANGELS!

40. Go SLIDING

• THE TERRAIN MAY BE FLAT, BUT THAT DOESN'T MEAN WE CAN'T TRY OUR HAND AT SLIDING. SEE IF YOU CAN BUILD A BACKYARD RAMP TO SLIDE DOWN!

41. CREATE A PLAY

• GIVE YOUR CHILDREN A LIST OF ITEMS TO FIND AND BRING BACK TO YOU FROM AROUND THE HOME. GET CREATIVE SO THEY HAVE TO COVER ALL CORNERS OF THE HOUSE!

45. BUILD A SNOW FORT

 THERE ARE A VARIETY OF OPTIONS OF SNOW FORT, BUT ONE OF THE EASIEST IS TO PILE SNOW AND THEN DIG OUT FROM THE MIDDLE! ADMITTEDLY MORE WORK INTENSIVE FOR PARENTS THAN THE CHILDREN, BUT GET THEM HELPING!

46. CREATE A COLLAGE

EITHER GET OUT OLD MAGAZINES, OR PRINT SOME PICTURES FOR THEM FROM ONLINE OR FROM YOUR OWN PERSONAL COLLECTION. LET THEM GO CRAZY WITH GLUE AND TAPE IN CREATING WHAT WILL BE A BEAUTIFUL COLLAGE!

47. CREATE A FLIPPY BOOK

TEACH YOUR CHILDREN ABOUT THE POWER OF ANIMATION BY DEVELOPING A "FLIPPY" BOOK CARTOON.

48. GO CAMPING INDOORS

• IF YOU ARE REALLY BRAVE, THIS COULD BE AN OVERNIGHT THING. SET UP A TENT, LET EVERYONE CAMP OUT. TELL STORIES, USE FLASHLIGHTS, AND HAVE FUN!

49. CREATE AN INDOOR OBSTACLE COURSE

REMEMBER, THE FLOOR IS LAVA! SET UP PILLOWS, CHAIRS, ETC. THAT THEY CAN JUMP FROM ONE TO THE NEXT ON.

50. PAPIER MACHE

Requires very limited supply but endless fun. Have the kids pick a shape they would like to make and go crazy
with some Papier Mache. Let it dry and have them paint it the following day

51. BURY YOUR LEGS

GO OUTSIDE AND LET YOUR CHILDREN BURY YOUR LEGS IN THE SNOW. TAKE TURN BURYING THEIRS TOO!

52. MAKE A VOLCANO

57. PLAY BALLOON PING PONG

INFLATE SOME BALLOONS, AND BOUNCE THEM AROUND. SEE HOW MANY BALLOONS YOU CAN KEEP UP IN THE AIR AT A TIME!

58. MAKE LIFE-SIZED DRAWINGS

TAPE SOME PAPER TOGETHER AND TRACE OUT YOUR BODIES. LET THEM COLOUR THEIR OWN BODY IN.

59. COLOUR THE YARD WITH SNOW PAINT!

 WE HAVE USED FOOD COLOURING BUT SOME BLOGS SAY TO ALSO USE POWDERED TEMPERA PAINT. THEN PUT IT IN SPRAY BOTTLES OR OLD KETCHUP BOTTLE AND GO COLOUR THE YARD!

60. CREATE A WORD SEARCH

PICK OUT A FEW OF YOUR FAVOURITE WORDS AND HIDE THEM WITHIN A WORD SEARCH. THEN SEE IF YOUR FAMILY MEMBERS
CAN FIND THEM!

61. PRINT OUT AND COMPLETE A COLOUR BY NUMBERS

Google "Colour by Numbers" and you will have plenty of options to choose from! Have fun!

62. PLAY WITH THE DRESS UP BOX

Dig to the bottom of it, come up with some cool and creative costumes and have a fashion show!

63. MAKE A WOODSY MOBILE

• SCAVENGE OUTSIDE FOR SOME COOL STICKS AND OTHER MATERIALS, AND MAKE YOURSELF A COOL MOBILE WITH SOME YARN AND THE STICKS YOU'VE COLLECTED!

64. CREATE INDOOR HOP SCOTCH

GET OUT SOME MASKING TAPE AND TAPE OUT A HOP SCOTCH COURSE ON THE CARPET. GET CREATIVE!

65. CREATE A MINI GOLF COURSE

• THIS CAN BE DONE WITH PLASTIC CUPS PLACED STRATEGICALLY AROUND THE HOME. YOU JUST HAVE TO DETERMINE THE DIFFICULTY AND OBSTACLES FOR EACH HOLE!

66. PLAY MUSICAL STATUES

• SIMILAR TO MUSICAL CHAIRS, LET SOMEONE DJ FOR YOU AND DANCE YOUR HEART OUT UNTIL THE MUSIC STOPS. POINTS CAN BE GIVEN FOR CREATIVE AND FUNNY STATUE POSES!

67. GO ON A COLOUR HUNT

PICK OUT 10 COLOURS AND GO OUTSIDE AND SEE IF YOU CAN SPOT THEM. WHEN YOU DO, JOT DOWN YOUR OBSERVATIONS AND
WHERE YOU SAW THE COLOUR!

68. MAKE A STAINED GLASS WINDOW

• WE USED TO MAKE COOL CELLOPHANE AND TISSUE PAPER WINDOWS. DESIGNATE A WINDOW IN THE HOME THAT WOULD BE THE PERFECT SPOT FOR YOUR STAINED GLASS CREATION!

69. CREATE AND HANG A BIRD FEEDER

• JUST BECAUSE IT IS WINTER DOESN'T MEAN THE BIRDS AREN'T STILL AROUND! CREATE A BIRD FEEDER OUT OF AN OLD MILK CARTON AND HANG IT SOMEWHERE THAT THE KIDS CAN SEE!

70. HIDE AND SEEK IN THE DARK

• SIMILAR TO THE HIDE AND SEEK ABOVE, BUT THIS TIME DO IT IN THE DARK, WITH FLASHLIGHTS. IF IT ISN'T DARK ENOUGH IN YOUR HOME, HEAD TO THE BASEMENT!

71. MAKE AND DECORATE SOME CUPCAKES

FIND A NEW RECIPE AND BAKE SOME DELICIOUS CUPCAKES. YOU DON'T NEED FANCY TOOLS TO DECORATE YOUR CUPCAKES
 EITHER. A ZIPLOC WITH A CORNER CUT OFF SERVES AS THE PERFECT PIPING UTENSIL!

72. MAKE A TIME CAPSULE

WE MAY NEVER BE TOLD AGAIN IN OUR LIVES TO SELF-ISOLATE. TAKE ADVANTAGE AND CREATE A TIME CAPSULE TO BE
OPENED IN A FEW YEARS. WRITE LETTERS TO YOURSELF, PERHAPS PUT SOME COOL ARTICLES, AND YOUR OWN PREDICTIONS.

73. LEARN THE ART OF ORIGAMI

80. CHOREOGRAPH A DANCE!

 WATCH ONLINE VIDEOS FOR SOME COOL DANCE MOVES, OR LET YOUR CHILD COME UP WITH THEIR OWN MOVES. PICK A COOL SONG AND VIDEO TAPE YOUR CREATED DANCE

81. AT HOME DAY SPA

WHIP OUT YOUR ROBES! SET UP A MANICURE OR PEDICURE STATION. WASH YOUR FACES AND PUT LOTION ON. BONUS POINTS
IF YOU HAVE CUCUMBERS FOR THE EYES!

82. PLAY THE OUTDOOR "SPOTTING" GAME

• COME UP WITH A LIST OF 15-20 ITEMS THAT YOU OFTEN SEE IN AND AROUND YOUR BACKYARD. GO OUTSIDE, SEE IF YOU CAN "TICK" ALL OF THE BOXES!

83. MAKE A SHOEBOX DIORAMA

Have your child pick a scene that they would like to create, and decorate a shoebox accordingly.

88. MAKE PAPER HATS

 CREATE SOME COOL SHAPED HAPS - A PIRATE HAT, A CHEF HAT, ETC. YOU NAME IT, YOU CAN CREATE IT. BONUS POINTS FOR COOL ACCESSORIES!

89. CROSS STITCH

• TEACH YOUR CHILD HOW TO CROSS STICH BY PUNCHING HOLES AND DRAWING NUMBERS IN CARDBOARD. THEN PROVIDE THEM WITH THE YARN AND SHOW THEM HOW TO CREATE COOL CROSS STITCH PATTERNS!

90. INDOOR SNOWBALL FIGHT

• IF WEATHER PLUNGES TOO MUCH, AN INDOOR SNOWBALL FIGHT WOULD BE A GREAT WAY TO PASS THE TIME. JUST GET SOME BALLED UP SOCKS, BUILD YOUR SHELTERS, AND DON'T SURRENDER!

91. Have an Outdoor Scavenger Hunt

PROVIDE YOUR CHILD WITH A LIST OF ITEMS YOU WANT THEM TO FIND OUTSIDE. GIVE POINTS FOR EACH ITEM AND SEE HOW
MANY THEY CAN FIND!

92. HAVE A PUZZLE DAY

• WE HAVE BEEN GIFTED WITH MANY PUZZLES THAT HAVE NOW BECOME ALL JUMBLED IN ONE DRAWER. PULL THEM ALL OUT, SEPARATE THE PIECES INTO ZIPLOCS, AND LET YOUR CHILD FINISH THEM AS YOU GO.

93. CREATE YOUR OWN MATCHING GAME

Cut out some paper in the shape/size of cards. Have your child color sets of two matching pictures to create
their own matching game. Then play with the cards they have created!

94. DECORATE SOME EASTER EGGS

95. HAVE AN OUTDOOR OBSTACLE COURSE

96. CREATE A HOT CHOCOLATE STATION

• PERFECT AFTER AN OUTDOOR ACTIVITY - MAKE SOME HOT CHOCOLATE FROM SCRATCH USING COCOA, SUGAR, AND MILK. LET YOUR CHILDREN DRESS UP THEIR HOT CHOCOLATE WITH WHIPPING CREAM, MARSHMALLOWS, SPRINKLES, ETC.



97. COFFEE FILTER ART

Have your children colour coffee filters, then spray with water for a cool tie-dye effect!

98. PLAY WILL IT SINK OR FLOAT?
